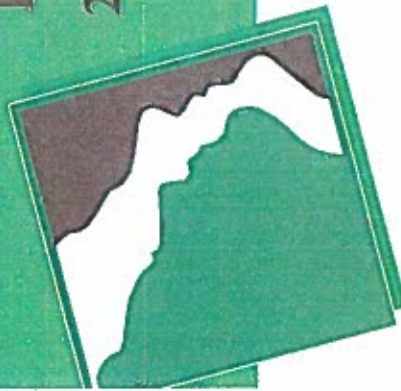

- Your application form must be included in essay PDF file or attached to e-mail as a separate PDF.
- Entries must be e-mailed by February 15, 2019.
